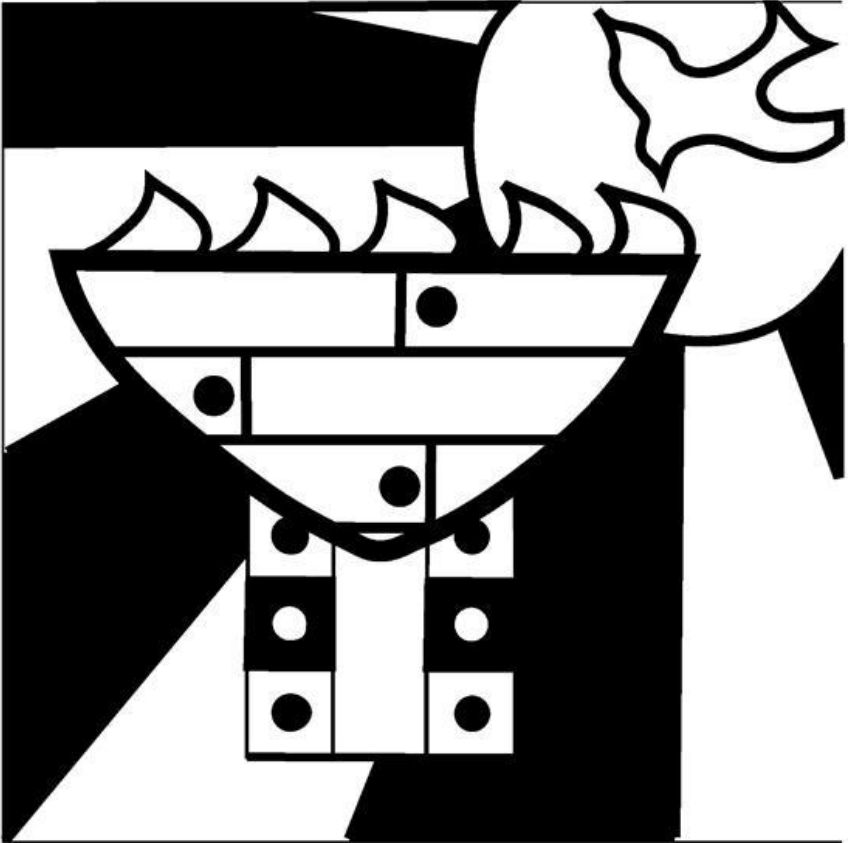


GRACE AT HOME

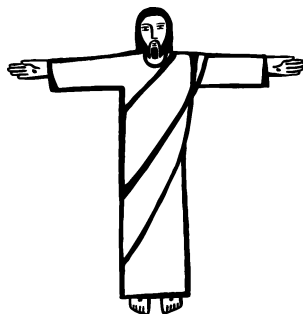

THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

The Tenth Commandment
