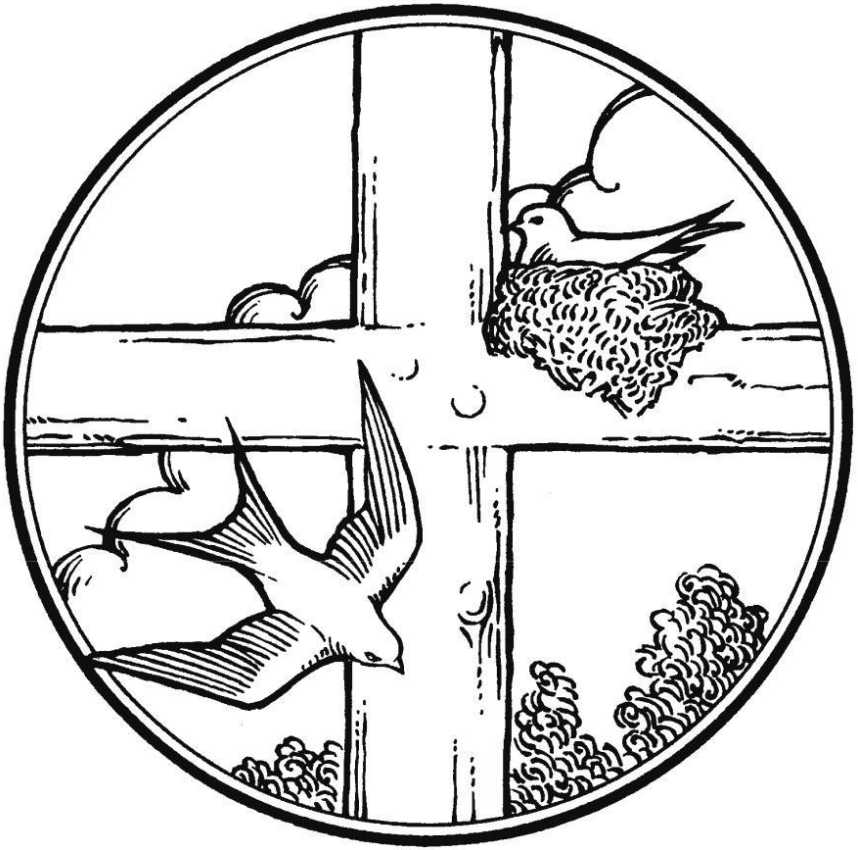


GRACE AT HOME

CONFESSION

How might we confess our sins privately?

Then we should name the sins that trouble us. We may close the confession with the words, "I repent of all these sins and pray for mercy. I promise to do better with God's help."
