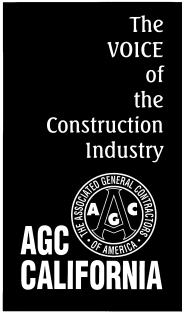

Improving Access to Surety Credit with agcXML

Technical Session

The construction industry is transitioning to online systems for BIM, prequalification, procurement and project management. A pioneer in developing leading technologies is Caltrans, from online procurement advertising to progress payment transparency that enables performance measurement both internally and externally.

AGC of America developed an open data standard, agcXML, to provide resources to public agencies like Caltrans as they strive to implement policies and procedures that promote open standards for interoperability and avoid proprietary systems, exclusivity or endorsements to vendors.

California State University Chico is a leading campus for BIM and the premiere source of high quality graduates for the construction industry. Together with K. Dixon Wright of Wells Fargo Insurance Services CSU Chico has been working with AGC on the Surety Connection Project to develop shareware prototype applications designed to identify and “tag” data fields for agcXML that can be utilized by the construction industry.

Tracy Gateway Business Park is a private developer sponsoring the Surety Connection Project at CSU Chico to broaden the participation of local small and emerging contractors in the build out of the business park, and the construction of the Lammers Road Interchange.

The goal of the Surety Connection Project is to provide educational opportunities for students that promote open standards and interoperability so the resulting efficiency improves access to surety credit for small and emerging contractors. It accomplishes this objective by reducing a major barrier; the cost in both dollars and time to the contractor associated with procuring work and the cost to the surety industry to manually administer and process paper surety bonds while cost effectively improving the underwriting information to the surety industry.

Imagine the cost savings of a common questionnaire that a contractor can easily maintain and upload to any number of systems, public and private, to apply to a surety, bank or government program, or to prequalify with prime contractors.

Imagine the cost savings of a contractor being able to download and import bid information that can easily be forwarded to their surety broker to generate bond approvals and electronic bonds without errors, or excess processing costs to their surety broker.

Imagine the underwriting flexibility a surety can offer when provided real time performance measurement that allows monitoring of the credit exposure.

Imagine no more, and come learn about the Surety Connection Project and watch us demonstrate how agcXML is making this goal a reality.
