

30 Days of Prayer for the Muslim World

- 02.28-the Tuareg of West Africa: Pray that God would reveal to the Tuareg, a proud people, their need for repentance and the joy of freedom in Christ; for audio Scripture resources to be distributed more freely; and that God would raise up believers to be church leaders in their community. (Acts 3:19)
- 03.01-the Turks in the Earthquake Zone: Pray that God will draw those copying out the Scriptures to Himself, that new believers will remain firm in their decision to follow Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord, and that God would make the church a light pointing many to Christ. (Psalm 119:130)
- 03.02-the Pashtuns: Pray that isolated believers would receive comfort and instruction from the Holy Spirit, for the translation and distribution of Scripture resources in the various dialects of Pashto, for discipleship of believers, and for the emergence of godly church leaders. (Proverbs 30:5)
- 03.03-the Kazakhs from China: Pray that Kazakhs living abroad will feel a longing to know their Creator and that nothing else (education, career, money, emigration, even family) can satisfy; that they will meet “Jesus-followers” along their paths in pursuit of worldly ambitions, that Kazakhs would have the opportunity and desire to read scripture, and that they would receive understanding through the Holy Spirit.
- 03.04-Zanzibar: Pray young believers will take courageous steps of obedience and not allow themselves to be prevented by baptism rumors; that Jesus would answer their prayers when they pray in His name; for supernatural protection and care for believers being persecuted by religious leaders and neighbors. (Is 42:10)
- 03.05-Albania: Pray that Albanians will become grounded in the Word, that the Muslim missionaries there from other countries will fall in love with Jesus instead, for unity between churches, and that believers will be known for their love. (John 3:16)
- 03.06-the Dendi of Northern Benin: Pray that those listening to the SD-cards will believe in the Messiah, that these people will see Jesus’ power over the spirit world; that a discipleship movement of 1000 or more baptisms and 100 house churches will emerge. (Isaiah 55:11)
- 03.07-Sandzak of the Balkans: Pray that more of these Muslims will recognize Jesus as the truth and follow Him, that His light is stronger than all the dark powers they have experienced, and for more workers and new ideas on how to reach this group.
- 03.08-Comoros Archipelago: Pray the fragrance of God spreads throughout the Perfume Islands and the people experience Him; that they may live safely and securely, and for Bible translation progress with great unity in the team. (2 Corinthians 2:15-16)
- 03.09-the Aimaqs of Afghanistan: Pray for the good news to be shared in regions with no gospel witness; that they find hope and know the Lord as their great provider; and that young Aimaq men find the gospel as they travel for work.
- 03.10-Libya: Pray that those suffering in prison will be released (Heb 13:13), that media outreach efforts would draw people to Christ as well as comfort and disciple secret believers; that those who have emigrated to other countries will find Christ and then return to share with their own people. (Isaiah 61:1)
- 03.11-Biharis in Bangladesh: Pray that these experiencing persecution and rejection would find their identity in Christ; improved conditions for those living in camps and that they discover Jesus as their True Hope; and for educational opportunities for their youth. (Psalm 107:6)
- 03.12-Muslims in Thailand: Pray for these Thai Muslims who have an interest in Jesus but struggle to learn more and for Christian friends who can explain more to them; for the growth of the church (70 + Christians amongst a million Muslim residents); and for more workers to reap the coming harvest. (Matthew 9)
- 03.13-Azerbaijan: Pray protection for these believers as they share their faith; for social media sharing of the Gospel; and for fellowships of believing Azeris to emerge in areas with no church.

- 03.14-the Shabaks of Iraq: Pray for translation progress and upcoming release of Gospel of Luke; that many Shabaks will read, hear, and listen to the Word in their own language; and for God’s Kingdom to take root in the Nineveh Plains.
- 03.15-Jihadist in Burkina Faso: Pray that Christians would repent for wrong attitudes against these peoples; for God to reveal corruption keeping people in poverty; to find solutions; and for God to open the hearts of many terrorists to hear and accept the Gospel. (Psalm 27:1)
- 03.16-Uzbekistan: Pray for freedom of religion there; for the safety, growth, and spiritual maturity of those in underground churches; and that local pastors will be taught by the Holy Spirit to lead their flocks and withstand persecution. (Hebrews 4:12)
- 03.17-the Western Cham of Cambodia: Pray the Word will penetrate their hearts; for Mei as she testifies to others; for more family members to join the community and grow spiritually. (John 15:7)
- 03.18-Asylum seekers of Europe: Pray the Christian refugees in danger of deportation; for boldness to discuss the Bible with their Muslim friends; for revelation as they read God’s Word; and for access to resources to help them on their journey. (Leviticus 19:34)
- 03.19-the Minangkabau in Indonesia: Pray God will give understanding of His Word, release them from fear of reading the Bible, and show them ways to hear the Good News; and for those who spread fear to stop and be released from bondage themselves by following Christ. (John 14:26)
- 03.20-the Saraiki of Pakistan: Pray they will encounter Jesus through dreams and visions; they will hear the good news through social media connections; for protection; and for courage and wisdom in sharing their faith. (1 John 5:14-15)
- 03.21-Palestinians in Jordan: Pray for courage and hunger in Muslim women to read God’s Word; for spiritually blind eyes to be opened to Jesus and trust in Him; and for the Prince of Peace to enter and transform family networks by His Word. (Ephesians 3:9)
- 03.22-Dagestan: Pray that seekers will have access to Scriptures in their own language; for protection; and for Dagestani church to reach out to other Caucasian peoples. (Luke 19:10)
- 03.23-the Oromo in Ethiopia: Pray for the followers of Jesus and few churches here; for courage and wisdom to share the Gospel; and for opportunities to encourage each other. (Deuteronomy 31:6)
- 03.24-Dungans of Central Asia: Pray their work will bear fruit; for the Bible translation team; and that God would raise up “near-culture” workers from China or Asia to work with Dungans. (Deuteronomy 32:2)
- 03.25-Tajikistan: Pray that seekers will have access to Scriptures in their own language; for economic breakthroughs; and that small local churches would reveal Christ. (Psalm 119:105)
- 03.26-Night of Power: Pray for Muslims to have miraculous encounters with Jesus (John 20:30-31); for a revelation of forgiveness through Jesus (Titus 3:5); and for Christian workers to have opportunities to pray in Jesus’ name for their Muslim friends.
- 03.27-Iranians in Northern Ireland: Pray for Christians in the west to open their homes in hospitality to Muslims and invite Muslim friends to study the Bible with them; and for new believers to grow in their faith and be welcomed by local churches. (John 8:12)
- 03.28-Hadjarai of the Sahel: Pray for translation and literacy work in all the Hadjarai languages; for creative ways to share the Gospel with the “not-yet-literate”; and for peace and stability in Chad. (Hebrews 1:2)
- 03.29-Miracle in Gaza: Pray for peace between Palestinians and Israelis; comfort for the traumatized in Gaza; and for peaceful political solutions resulting in an end to war and terror. (John 1:14)
