

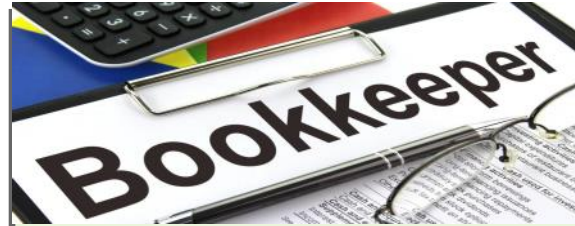
Lent Study Begins Feb. 22

Part-time Bookkeeper Wanted

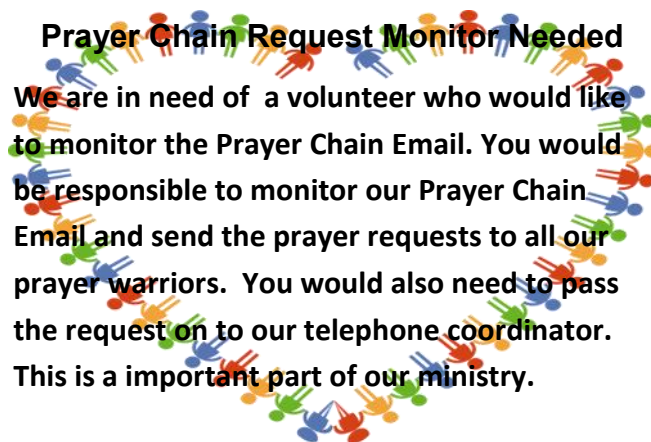

An Invitation to Mendocino

You are all invited to join our mission/outreach team on a mission trip to the Mendocino Redwoods Retreat Center where we will do some repairs and painting. The trip is scheduled for January 27th through the 31st.

The retreat center is run by Rev. Dr. Sunny Farley Brown who is doing her best to refurbish this beautiful but neglected retreat. She has a vision for a summer youth camp as is eager to get the facilities in ship-shape. She is also looking for funding. We're looking into some conference sources for her. Maybe you know of a source.

On the grounds, there are cabins, hot showers, a full kitchen and a chapel. The area is only a mile from the coast in Little River. The cost for the trip is \$60.00 per volunteer to cover the cost of food and transportation, (\$50.00 for drivers). There is some scholarship money available though all participants are required to give something towards the trip.

Applications for the trip will be available the week of December 29th. You can pick them up in the church office or see Kathleen Mirtoni. All paperwork and fees are due by January 19th.

Even if you can't attend, you can be a part of the mission by donating money to help fund the project or sponsor a team member. Of course, your prayers are always appreciated.
