
A (TRUE) PANTRY STORY

I was working at the food pantry on a Wednesday night. Three kids whom I guessed were in their early teens were waiting in the foyer for their mother to finish shopping. They were going to be carrying the groceries as they walked home. One of them spotted the black plastic sack with the sign saying "Pantry Donations" sitting on a shelf and asked me what was donated. I told them about the milk bottles that were made into laundry detergent containers, and then I said that most of the food was either donated or purchased with money donated to the pantry, and that some of us volunteered our time to help distribute it.

The oldest girl said, "Why do you do this?" And I said, "We follow Jesus, and Jesus said, 'If you love me, feed my sheep." She laughed and said "So, I'm a sheep?" And I said, "Jesus was known as the Good Shepherd and we're ALL his sheep." I thought the conversation was over, but a few minutes later they all came to me and said they wanted to volunteer!

The moral of this story is: if you want to show you love Jesus, volunteer to work in the pantry on Wednesday at 6:00 pm or on Monday or Friday at 9:00 am or at 10:00 am on the second Saturday of the month, when the pantry is open at the same time as the Legal Clinic.
