President, Mona M Malbranche - Final Message as President - March 2021

Several years ago a gentleman by the name of Hubie Klombers (a person whom I did not know) sent a message to me to run for the Board of Directors of the Democratic Club in Kings Point in Tamarac. He was concerned that there wasn't enough diversity in the Club nor was there any on the Board. I complied because it was a challenge. I campaigned one day, and lo and behold, won. By the way our Club, with a membership of 500, only had two *Black* members. Mr. Klombers was the treasurer of the Board. That year, two of us became the first Black women on the board.

I represented diversity in that I was not just a *Black* woman but, a Haitian- American woman from the Caribbean. After 5 years, this woman became the first Black woman President in the history of this Club.

My goal for the Club was and continues to be, to get out the vote with joy & excitement, & to provide great knowledge and resources to our club and community. In order to do that ALL candidates (not just judicial) had to meet, greet, break bread, and mingle with the Kings Point seniors. We are an active living, senior community. It meant making sure that seniors continue to fulfill their civic duties. The Kings Point residents vote more than any other group. We're usually more civic minded, as many have lived through *the Great Depression, two World Wars and other conflagrations.*

In 2018, the Club entertained everyone on the ballot except for two candidates. In 2020, we could not do the same due to the *pandemic*, but we did our best; our seniors voted. The Club has become more diversified, We have lost many due to moving from Kings Point, illnesses, and sadly, death. At present we have a total of 39 Blacks and 5 Latinos in this Democratic Club. We hope to have even more diversification, as we engage and educate more people.

I want to thank the Board, the Elected officials and the entire membership for the respect, trust, love, and appreciation for my vision. Thank you for the support that I received since joining you. I hope that you will continue the fight to make *Florida blue*. I will remain on the board as Past President and will hopefully be a valuable resource for Julie and the Club's new Board. *Thank you and God bless all of you*

**“WHAT THE HELL DOES THIS 21st CENTURY

Such a maneuver may not be the nicest, cleanest way to achieve our party’s objectives. But it’s time we fight Republican fire with some of our own. GUN VIOLENCE - MASS SHOOTINGS

For this article, my statistics define mass shootings as occurrences in which 4 or more persons are injured., as a direct result of that shooting incident. Does it seem like the there have been a growing number of these mass shootings, or are we just watching tv and reading news reports more often, during these covid times? We are less than 3 months into t2021. As of the date of my article (March 22nd), try to take a guess, of just how many mass shootings have taken place in the United States, in the first 80+ days 2021?

A - 33

B - 78

C - 107



If you opted for the max number of 107, you are correct. There have been a staggering 107 mass shooting incidents since New Years, with 122 fatalities, and an additional 378 people injured. The above numbers include shooting sprees that we've become accustomed to hearing about like schools, churches, malls, and clubs - but also include gang-related incidents and domestic violence acts that fit the pre-requisite numbers.

I did read that Great Britain and many other European nations were concerned with their number of "knife" incidents, while their gun violence numbers remain close to nil. Why are we, the United States, who claims to be the greatest nation in the world, so deluged with such violent behavior?

Our fatality victims include children, pregnant women, parents, grandparents, police and first responders, teachers, clergy, students, and multitudes of others - too often identified by race, religion, sexual identity and other minority groups. Leadership, including Congress has failed us, by bending to the will of special interests and abject failure of not being proactive or even reactive.

Despite 100s of 1000's incidents in the past century, Congressional Republicans refuse to make substantive changes, in woefully lacking weapon licensing laws, regarding training, background due-diligence, and restrictions. Interestingly, so many states are so overly concerned today with voting restrictions to combat less than 1500 ever documented cases of voter fraud, while gun violence murders take a far-distant background seat. It really makes no sense. It really infuriates me!

If the Republicans won't act, the Democrats must take immediate emergency-type actions. As in an earlier article in this newsletter, the answer is that the Democratic Senate has to change the "filibuster" rules, to allow for a 51 vote majority to pass new laws. These actions are so very critical to our nation's safety. We need to fix this major problem - now! LET'S GO SENATE... DAMNIT!
