

Sunday Market Kids Stallholders FAQs

What is the Sunday Market?

The Preston South Primary School Sunday Market will be held on Sunday 10 November from 10am - 4pm and promises a fun day out with locally sourced goods and foods created by local businesses (and you!) as well as fun activities for all the family. There will be food and refreshments, entertainment and games on offer across the day.

What is the aim of the market?

The Sunday Market aims to engage the local community to welcome friends and families of the school, showcase the new school building to the surrounding community and fundraise for new resources and furniture for the school library.

What time will the kids stall run?

Kids stalls open at 10am and will run until 2pm. If you want to stay until the market finishes at 4pm, you are welcome to.

What equipment will be provided for the kids' stalls?

Each stall will be provided a 120x60cm table and two chairs. .

Will there be shade?

Yes, the kids stalls will be held under temporary shelters so if it rains (or is really sunny) you should be fine. We do recommend bringing a hat and sunscreen regardless.

What is acceptable to be sold at the market?

Homemade goods, arts and crafts, home grown plants or herbs, second hand toys or books. If you wish to sell food, you or your parent will need to hold a food handling certificate. These can be obtained free from DOFoodSafely website:.

Alcohol, tobacco and adult products are prohibited.

How can I prepare for the market?

Display: Think about the product you are selling and how it can be displayed effectively. Try a practice run at home and take photos so you can just copy this on market day.

Pricing: Think about your pricing, if you were a customer what would you pay for your product? Make sure your prices are displayed clearly.

Food Handling: If you are selling food, don't forget to get a food handling certificate (see above)

Payments: How will you accept payments on the day? Make sure you have enough cash for change etc.

Packaging: If you are putting your product into something (like a bag), think about the best way this will be disposed of and any environmental impacts.

Promote! Tell your friends and family you are going to be there so they can come along and support you!

Can I share a stall with another kid?

Yes, as long as the products you are selling fit on the 1.2m table.

Will kids stalls be supervised or does a parent have to be with their kid at all times?

Stalls will not be supervised and must have a parent present at all times.

What time should I arrive to set up?

Set up times and your stall location will be communicated to you closer to the date, along with safety guidelines etc.

Do I keep the money that I make from the stall?

Absolutely! Any money you make on the day is yours. However some stall holders have elected to donate a proportion of their sales to the school fundraiser (eg, 5% or 10% of sales)

Can I donate the money to the school?

Absolutely! Any donations we receive on the day will be going to the school library resources.

Are there toilets available?

Yes, there are facilities provided.

What happens if it rains?

The market will be going ahead come rain hail or shine!

What if we have a stall and cannot attend on the day?

Please advise us if you cannot make it. We are unable to offer refunds for stall holders who can no longer attend.

Do all stall holders need to bring their own float / change?

Yes.
