

CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR HEAT PRESS GARMENTS

Washing Instructions:

Turn the garment inside out before washing to protect the heat-pressed logo.

Use cold or warm water settings (preferably below 20°C).

Wash on a gentle cycle with mild detergent.

Avoid using bleach, fabric softeners, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the design.

Do not overload the washing machine; wash similar colors together.

Drying Instructions:

Air drying is the best option for heat press garments. Lay the garment flat or hang it to dry away from direct sunlight.

If you must use a dryer, choose a low-heat or tumble-dry setting. High heat settings can cause the design to crack, peel, or fade over time.

Ironing Instructions:

Turn the garment inside out before ironing.

Use a low heat setting and avoid ironing directly over the heat press.

Steam is not recommended, as it may affect the adhesive bond of the heat press.

Storage Instructions:

Store the garments in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight, to prevent fading. Fold them neatly without placing heavy items on top to avoid creasing the design.

Additional Tips:

Avoid dry cleaning, as the chemicals used may damage the heat-pressed design. If the garment becomes stained, spot clean gently with a mild detergent before washing.
