Club Housekeeping

A Letter from The West Coast Yacht Club Flag Officers and Board of Directors

Dear West Coast Yacht Club Members,

The Flag Officers and Board members would like to take a moment to clarify our event participation and reservation policies. These guidelines are intended to ensure fairness to all members and to help the Club manage event commitments and expenses responsibly.

As many of you know, cruise events often require advance commitments for meals, refreshments, marina arrangements, and other event-related provisions. Once the Club confirms attendance numbers with vendors and hosts, costs are incurred on behalf of those who have RSVP'd.

Accordingly, members who attend any portion of a cruise event are expected to pay the established event fee, regardless of the extent of their participation. This applies whether or not a member chooses to partake in scheduled meals, breakfasts, happy hours, alcoholic beverages, or other event amenities. Attendance at any part of the event constitutes participation for purposes of event planning and cost allocation.

Additionally, members who cancel their RSVP after the published reservation cutoff date remain responsible for payment of the event fee. Because commitments and purchases are often finalized based on reservation counts, late cancellations may result in unrecoverable costs to the Club.

Members who bring a guest to an event without prior reservation are also responsible for the guest's event fee. This expectation applies even if the guest attends only a portion of the event. We appreciate members helping us maintain accurate attendance counts whenever possible so that adequate accommodations can be made for all attendees.

The Flag Officers and Board members recognize that unforeseen circumstances can arise. Therefore, the Flag Officers retain the discretion to waive, reduce, or reimburse event fees when circumstances warrant special consideration. Requests for such consideration will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis, with the goal of balancing fairness to the individual member and the financial responsibilities of the Club.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation. These policies help ensure that West Coast Yacht Club can continue to provide enjoyable and well-organized events while managing Club resources responsibly and equitably for all members.

Greetings Everyone! - **PLEASE READ ALL THE WAY THROUGH - IMPORTANT TRIP INFORMATION**

Well, we have 19 people and 10 boats signed up for the upcoming cruise! A great turn out for WCYC.....

The weekend should prove to be very memorable if it's anything like last year, and from our planning sessions we have had it should surpass last year by leaps and bounds! It looks like we will have about 140 people in attendance and about 55 boats attending between all of the clubs. Clubs attending: Shoreline YC, Little Ships Fleet YC, Huntington Harbor YC, Cerritos Bahia Yacht Club. And ourselves.

A few housekeeping items between now and then:

Please let me know what day you are planning on heading over, we have a form that our group needs to submit to the harbor department and I have most to everyone's needed information (name, phone, email, boat name, boat length, CF or Doc #, arrival date and departure date) however I don't have everyone's arrival date. Please review the attachment and let me know of any changes to the information. Can you send over to me via text your anticipated arrival date and or any missing information for your boat. 619-933-6209.

Note if you are planning to go over on Friday morning, you can make a reservation on Thursday night after 8:00 p.m. I highly encourage you to make a reservation on Thursday to help ensure your pick of moorings for your weekend stay. <https://ivr.netmooring.com/NetMooring2H/>. If you are headed over on Thursday am or earlier, this should not be an issue.



We are looking for a volunteer boat to be the host boat for Friday night's Happy Hour Crawl. This would entail having your boat decorated in our club's theme (Redneck Yacht Club) Boat decorated with theme, servers dressed in theme and serving a small appetizer sampler and drink to 140 people. The club will be allocating a budget to assist with this drink and food endeavor. We are the 1st stop so you would serve the group of dinghies, (no one boards your boat - everyone stays in the water) and dinghies would hang out and receive their drink and treat for about 30 minutes, and when done serving and socializing, the group heads to the next boat - approximately 30 minutes at each boat.

As the first host, you can then hop in your dinghy and head out with the rest of the group and visit the other 4 boats that would be visited. The other boat themes are Miami Vice, Tiki Tacky, Bora Bora, and Island Patriots. They will have drink and food that matches their theme. There will be prizes for the best decorated theme boat and best Drink/appetizer presentation. Please note that some clubs have members double up to assist with the happy hour event. (2 couples on one boat helping serve the appetizers and food- makes less work for one couple) - PLEASE REACH OUT TO MARJI OR BRIAN ASAP IF YOU ARE WILLING TO BE THE FRIDAY HOST BOAT AS WE NEED TO MAKE PLANS.

We have custom cruise wrist bands that will be issued in your cruise bag (along with your Cruise T- shirt and Weekend Agenda card and laminated Dinghy menu cards) The wrist bands are needed for Saturday night's Dinner at the park. Please make sure you wear the band on Saturday night as it is required to receive your dinner. By all means you can wear it from the start so if you see someone with a wristband go up and introduce yourself. Bring a chair to have a seat in the park. Dinner will be a served Buffet from Avalon Smokehouse; BBQ Chicken, Pork, Portobello Mushroom (vegetarian) , Baked Beans , Macaroni and Cheese, and Rolls, butter, as well as a Cesar Salad. Desert will be an assortment of Cookies that each Club is bringing (Marji and I have that covered)



We will have an auction basket available for purchase for our club members. This trips Auction Basket is sure to please and extremely useful! A hint it is worth over \$300.00.

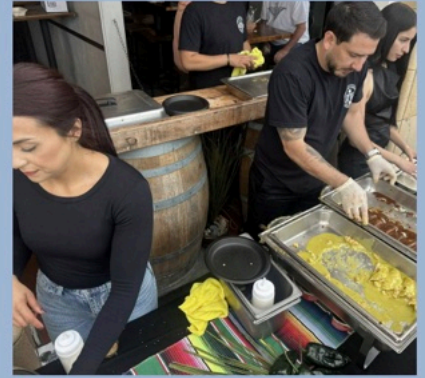

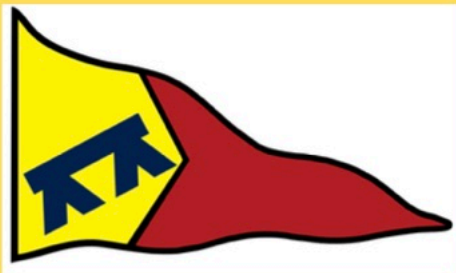

Boating safety is an important part of being a vessel owner. As an owner it is your responsibility to ensure the safety of yourself, family, and friends that you have as guests on your vessel.

The best way to do this is to have your vessel examined by the Coast Guard Auxiliary on an annual basis, ensuring that your vessel and safety equipment meets the current Coast Guard, State, and Federal requirements.

The Auxiliary has several resources where you can conduct a virtual VSC and prepare your vessel for the safety check.....
