Member Letter from Steve Fiorillo & the USCG Auxiliary

California Boater's Card

For those who are not aware, as of Jan 1 2025, anyone 16 years of age or older operating any privately owned vessel with an engine of more than 15HP or non-motorized sailboats over 30' LOA, must obtain a CA Boater's Card(CBC). Anyone from the ages of 12-17 may operate similar vessels while only under the supervision of someone 18 or older who has a CBC. If more than one person over the age of 18 is operating your vessel, then they also require a CBC.

Penalties for not having your CBC are as follows...First conviction: Up to \$100; Second conviction: Up to \$250; Third or subsequent conviction: Up to \$500

The CBC is a one-time certification. Information about the CBC can be found at https://californiaboatercard.com.

The class will cover what you need to know about operating a boat safely. 2025 USCG Auxiliary Vessel Safety Checks Flotilla 06-08 – Dana Point



Boating safety is an important part of being a vessel owner. As an owner it is your responsibility to ensure the safety of yourself, family, and friends that you have as guests on your vessel.

The best way to do this is to have your vessel examined by the Coast Guard Auxiliary on an annul basis, ensuring that your vessel and safety equipment meets the current Coast Guard, State, and Federal requirements.

The Auxiliary has several resources where you can conduct a virtual VSC and prepare your vessel for the safety check.....
