Getting Involved- Hosting Cruises By Brian Randall-Vice Commodore



For those who may not know..... generally, the cruises are led by a "Captain Host" and a "Co-Captain Host". Usually, two sets of members assisting each other in putting together the events of a cruise. Cruises typically run Friday through Sunday.

As Vice-Commodore, I will be working with the Captains and Co-Captains in sending Evites out, getting any necessary permits, and providing guidance to the organization of the cruise.

The main job of the Captains and Co-captains is to create an agenda for the cruise and arranging the activities, food, music/band (if providing one), etc. Typically, Friday night is an appetizer party, Saturday Mornings are drinks and treats on the back of someone's boat, followed by events, dinghy cruises, etc. Saturday night is a group dinner followed by some shenanigans.. Sunday the group departs from the location. The Sky is the limit on creativity!

We try to keep the costs to the members to a minimum. Some cruises require fees for dockage or moorings in addition to the "Cruise fee" from the club. If you would like to sign up for a cruise or assist someone on a cruise, please reach out to me. I would gladly discuss some options, and I can assist you along the way.

Getting involved by hosting a cruise may seem intimidating, but it is actually a lot of fun! It's just getting over the first time doing it, then you will be a pro. Also, there are many members who have hosted events in the past and are always available to help, so don't think you will be alone on a life raft!



2025 USCG Auxiliary Vessel Safety Checks Flotilla 06-08 – Dana Point



The best way to do this is to have your vessel examined by the Coast Guard Auxiliary on an annul basis, ensuring that your vessel and safety equipment meets the current Coast Guard, State, and Federal requirements.

The Auxiliary has several resources where you can conduct a virtual VSC and prepare your vessel for the safety check.....
