
# LETTER FROM REAR COMMODORE DAVE STANCIL

#### Hello All:

I want to start by thanking all that attended the March dinner at El Adobe in San Juan. We had a great time and celebrated the return of indoor dining in Orange County. Combined with the February dinner at Luciana's in Dana Point, our club met its 1<sup>st</sup> quarter goal of holding two social dinners. We were able to complete both dinners safely, and under COVID restrictions and protocols. Both venues did a great job, and we hope that you will support both of these restaurants as your individual dinner plans occur during the year.

On March 18th, Steve Fiorillo and I attended a CA Clean Boating Network Meeting (via Zoom) presented by the California State Parks. This very informative program covered topics such as Preventing Boat Sewage Pollution, Trash Management Entering the Ocean, California's Marine Protected Areas, and the California Boaters Card. I have downloaded copies of the individual presentations if anyone is interested.

On the topic of the California Boaters Card, the *Binnacle* has promoted the California Boaters Card in the past and my wife Tami studied and took the test in February (I got mine in 2019) and proudly received her card this month. Although most of us are not at the age requiring us to have this card, *it will be mandatory* for all by Jan 1, 2025, it is always good to refresh your safe boating skills, as Tami did. Regardless, I highly recommend that you, anyone operating your boat, or significant other take the test and get the card. Relative to additional boater education, on March 27<sup>th</sup> I attended additional training (via Zoom) conducted by the California State Parks and the California Coastal Commission. This program creates "*DOCKWALKERS*" to conduct outreach to create and educate boaters about environmentally sound boating practices. The 3-hour training program allowed me to renew by DOCKWALKER certification from my original training in 2012. I have handouts and some nice giveaways coming that I can distribute later in the summer.

## USCG AUX Bulletin BoardVessel Safety Checks -



#### USCG Auxiliary Vessel Safety Checks Flotilla 06-08 – Dana Point



The following are the current guidelines effective January 1, 2021, allowing the CG AUX to conduct VSCs while conforming with the current social distancing restrictions. However, as with all COVID restrictions they are subject to change.

The new VSC guidelines include:

- Each VSC must also have prior approval by the CG AUX approximately one week prior to the exam
- One examiner per vessel
- Exam to be competed in 30 minutes
- No boarding of the vessel
- Examiner and boat owner are to wear PPE and maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet
- All vessel safety equipment (PFDs, flares, fire extinguishers, holding tank seacock, sounding devices, etc) must be available for either physical or virtual(FaceTime/Skype/Zoom/Pictures) inspection

The CG AUX also have several resources where you can conduct a virtual VSC and prepare your vessel for the safety check.....
