# LETTER FROM COMMODORE MINDY SICARD

Dear WCYC Members,

As Jimmy Buffett once said, "Shells sink, dreams float, life's good on our boat."

We are all so fortunate to own a boat and to be part of this wonderful cruising club with members who use their boats on a regular basis. Not all clubs can say that. New members are required to own a boat; doesn't necessarily mean you have to take it out, but I am happy to say that so many of you do.

As Commodore, I have all the historical boxes that are filled with many memoirs dating back to the very beginning. I love history and have had a lot of fun exploring the many historical written material. One item that really impressed me was the West Coast Yacht Club Member's Handbook from 1961. In this handbook, it posted the history of the West Coast Yacht Club, and here is the history written on the first page of the handbook....

In July 1931 eight erstwhile young men, four of whom were watching the other four build their own boats, decided to form a yacht club. These boating enthusiasts constituted the charter membership of the present West Coast Yacht Club.

Being of the trailer class the boats were built in the respective owners' backyards. There is where the original group met and discussed the formation of the new club. By 1932 a constitution was drafted.

The fact that all members were still land sailors determined the adoption of the name "Hi-N-Dri Yacht Club." It was inevitable that the burgee should have as its keynote a sawhorse. The colors chosen were a combination of those used by USC and UCLA; the blue sawhorse superimposed on the yellow and red field.

Officers were chosen by a flip of the coin until 1934 when the membership had grown sufficiently to hold an election by ballot.

In March 1934 three Hi-N-Dri Yacht Club boats participated in the Mid-Winter Regatta. By 1935 this number increased to a total of fifteen entries. When the 1936 Mid-Winter Regatta rolled around the Hi-N-Dri Yacht Club had become a member of the Southern California Yacht Association (SCYA). Four Hi-N-Dri boats entered this regatta three of them winning trophies.

The growth of the club progressed so that in 1938 an active power cruise fleet had developed and was admitted to membership in the American Power Boat Association. In December of the same year the Los Angeles Flattee Fleet, sponsored by this club, was present with a charter from the Flattee Yacht Racing Association. Ed Elin, a Hi-N-Dri member won the International Championship for 1939.

It was in March 1939 that a final decision was made to change the name of the Hi-N-Dri Yacht Club. The former name was no longer indicative of the club activities. After some discussion the present name of the West Coast Yacht Club was chosen.

Since 1940 the WCYC has progressed considerably and has developed an active program. The WCYC began its activities by playing host to the International Flattee Championship races in August of 1940. The first Family Cruise to Catalina Island took place in October. This same year the Annual Fall Regatta was changed from a club event to an invitational affair.

In November 1942 the West Coast Yacht Club became incorporated. In building a calendar of events, the interests of the membership naturally had to be taken into consideration. The growth of the club since its inception showed a change from small boat sailors of the Flattee class to a combination of power and sail boats. There were class boats, ocean racing boats, power cruisers, large and small.

I love how West Coast Yacht Club instills tradition and continues to do some of the things the membership was doing back before most of us were even born.

I would like to share one more. Ever wonder where the "Sawhorse" came about? The nautical blunder? From the Handbook...

The "Sawhorse" was originally named the "Horse Laugh Trophy" – One of these trophies, which are little wooden saw horses (replicas of what appears in our Burgee) shall be presented at each dinner meeting, to the member who is nominated and elected, as guilty of committing the biggest nautical blunder. When the Commodore calls for nominations for the horse laugh trophy, be ready to tell all on your friends, or if necessary, defend yourself. It is always good for a laugh, so keep your eyes and ears open and come to the dinner meetings prepared to dish out some dirt.

I love how this is always the highlight of the night... may the traditions continue.

Recently, we had our first board meeting of the year, and I am so happy and proud to be part of this club and to be the Commodore. The members of the board are energetic, kind, fun and are ready for 2023.

See you on the seas in 2023.





# 2023 USCG Auxiliary Vessel Safety Checks Flotilla 06-08 – Dana Point



The following are the current 2023 guidelines allowing the CG AUX to conduct VSCs while conforming with the current social distancing restrictions. However, as with all COVID restrictions they are subject to change.

The new VSC guidelines include:

- As much as possible the exam should take place in the open air, however per the owner's permission, the examiner can now board the vessel to examine those items that cannot be brought topside
- One examiner per vessel
- Upon request, the examiner can wear PPE

The CG AUX also have several resources where you can conduct a virtual VSC and prepare your vessel for the safety check.....
