WCYC 2020 Vessel Safety Check Event

Hello All:

In previous years our club has invited the CG Auxiliary to our opening cruise in Long Beach to perform Vessel Safety Checks at the LBYC. Unfortunately this event hasn't occurred for the last two years since our opening cruise has been elsewhere.

I for one think this event is a great way to start our season and to ensure that our boats are not only up to CG standards, but are safe for all those we have onboard.

So on behalf of our commodore, and as a member of the CGA, I've arranged for the Auxiliary to perform Vessel Safety Checks(VSC) in Dana Point for whom ever would like one. The event will occur on either the first or second weekend in March and will be conducted in your slip.

If you haven't done it before, please don't feel intimidated by it. It is not legally required to obtain a VSC decal, nor is any deficit held against you or reported to anyone. A VSC is easy, free, takes about 30-45 minutes, and you may even learn a few things about your boat you didn't know, I know I have.

To understand what's required to obtain a decal, a copy of the checklist can be found at http://www.usps.org/door/vsc/2018-vsc-form.pdf. Only items 1-15 on the left side of the form are required, and some of those are LOA specific which may not apply to you(check back for explanations & requirements).

In the next few days I'll be sending out a sign up sheet so the Auxiliary can plan accordingly.

I encourage everyone who can to participate in this event.
