Ahoy All! As some of you may know I'm a member of the USCG and I manage the VSC function for the Dana Point Flotilla.

I'm working with Division to obtain all the proper publications and 2022 VE Decals so we can start examining vessels as soon as possible. Once we're ready to go, I'll let you all know and we can start scheduling VSCs.

As of now our COVID protocols are pretty straight forward and follow state recommendations of wearing masks in enclosed spaces and maintaining social distancing as much as feasibly possible, so the exams should be pretty straight forward as they have been prior to COVID.

If you who have never had your boat examined or if it's been a while, please don't be intimidated by the process, nor the examiners. We are not here to fail you! We want to see you pass, and will work with you before and during the VSC to make that happen.

I encourage everyone to have their vessel examined. It not only ensures your boat is safe for you and you passengers, but it could reduce some hassles if you're ever stopped by the Coast Guard.

Also back this year are our in-person Public Education Boating Courses. These include general boating skills, VHF radio basics, GPS for mariners, charting, and the one that highly recommend for all first & second mates is the Suddenly in Command class which teaches spouses and family members what to do if the captain is suddenly disabled. - Vessel Safety Checks -



USCG Auxiliary Vessel Safety Checks Flotilla 06-08 – Dana Point



The following are the current 2022 guidelines allowing the CG AUX to conduct VSCs while conforming with the current social distancing restrictions. However, as with all COVID restrictions they are subject to change.

The new VSC guidelines include:

- As much as possible the exam should take place in the open air, however per the owner's permission, the examiner can now board the vessel to examine those items that cannot be brought topside
- One examiner per vessel
- Examiner and boat owner are to wear PPE and maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet
