

The McNamara clan descended upon the BVI for the last week of 2016, and a memorable trip it was. The place is beautiful, with each island offering a new experience and "vibe." The people are extremely friendly, the water warm, the lobsters delicious and the rum drinks plentiful.

Although we had very high winds, we did sail and enjoyed the experience. We visited 8 islands: Tortola (the base island), Peter Island, Salt Island, Beef Island, Virgin Gorda, Saba Rock (the location of The Bitter End Yacht Club), Anegada Island and finally Norman Island (the location of the famous "Willy T's" Bar).

My favorites were Saba Rock, in the shadows of Neckar Island and Mosquito Island, both owned by Richard Branson, and the home of the Bitter End Yacht Club.
