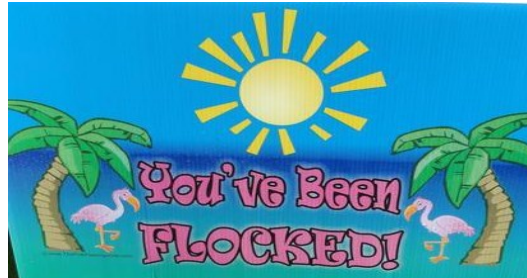

Congratulations to Easy Money & Last Tango for winning the boat decorating contest.

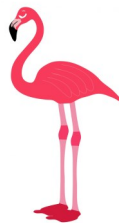

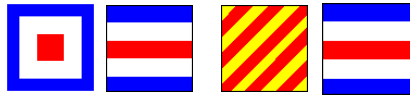
