## LETTER FROM COMMODORE, JAY GILL

I remember when I was very young I was afraid of the dark. Well, I can safely say that not much has changed. It has been decades since I sailed into an unfamiliar harbor at night. The April cruise to LBYC was the first time that I had ever entered Alamitos Bay. My arrival at 11:30 Thursday evening put me in an unfamiliar situation. Now, I have to say that I had been thinking about the approach for some time and I had anticipated that a nocturnal landing was going to be the way the trip would work out. So about six weeks ago I was up in the Long Beach area I went over to Alamitos Bay. I tried to familiarize myself with the approach, the harbor itself and how to get to LBYC. I also reviewed the So Cal Cruising Guide that has a detailed chart of the approach and the harbor itself. While I was in route I used the parallel rule of navigation to an almost ridiculous point. I was using the Raymarine chart plotter on board Victura, I also had CPN 4.0.0 which is an open source navigation software running, I had the Navionics app open on one iPhone and Marine Traffic open on another as well as the paper charts and cruising guide. At this point I should also mention that it was a full moon. And yet I was as nervous as could be. As you all know by now the approach and landing were uneventful. I am sure there would have been a sawhorse or two had there been some sort of mishap considering the reception party that was waiting for me (Jim McNamara and Scuba Steve Vandenberg). And yet, as prepared as I was and for all of the support equipment on board being accessed for a smooth arrival, it seems that no matter how old I get I am still afraid of the dark.

Thank you for the opportunity to serve you as Commodore.
