

Bylaw 6-17  
Resort Village of Cochin

**A BYLAW TO LIMIT AND CONTROL THE USE OF FIREWORKS IN THE RESORT  
VILLAGE OF COCHIN.**

The Resort Village of Cochin, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts the following:

1. Definition:

- a. "Fireworks" shall mean and include any combustible or explosive composition or any substance or combination of substances that produces a visible and audible effect by, explosion, deflagration or detonation.
- b. "Audience" refers to the people and the display that fireworks is intended for; for public or private recreation or entertainment.

2. Scope:

- a) No person(s) or organization may set off fireworks within the limits of the Resort Village of Cochin for ANY reason beyond 11:00p.m.
- b) The place for the setting-off of fireworks must be on the sand portion of the main beach, north of the breakwater and directed toward the water; and shall not be within fifty (50) meters of dwelling and/or flammable materials.
- c) The person or organization responsible for the setting-off of fireworks shall be responsible for cleanup of all related debris and hold all liability.

3. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect this 11<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2017.
