✂ Installation Instructions

1. Do not disassemble the main body, as it has been installed and commissioned correctly and precisely before leaving the factory.
2. To avoid the faucet from jamming, flush the water pipe before installation.
3. After installation, make sure every joint is safely sealed and there are no leaks.
4. Using condition: Working pressure at 0.05-1.0 MPa (including cold and hot water pressure), with applicable water temperature: 4°C-90°C.
5. Make sure to connect the hot and cold inlet pipes correctly. When standing in front of the faucet, connect the hot water pipe to the left and the cold water pipe to the right.
6. The mounting hole size is Ø35mm.

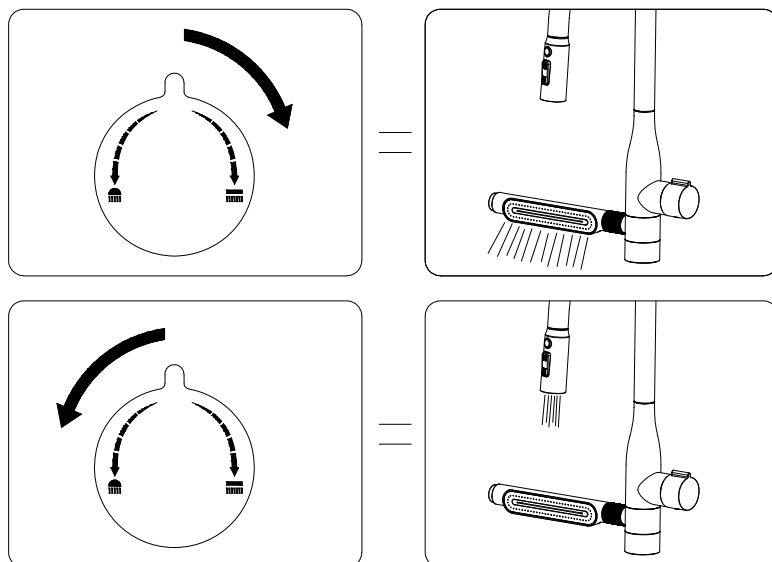

Handle Operation Guide



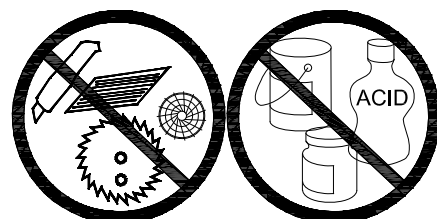
1. Rotate the handle clockwise to control the side spray. A larger rotation angle increases the water temperature. The water turns off automatically when the handle returns to the middle position.

2. Rotate the handle counterclockwise to control the spray water outlet. A larger rotation angle increases the water temperature. The water turns off automatically when the handle returns to the middle position.

※Cleaning & Maintenance

To keep the product clean and shining, please follow these steps:

1. Flush with clean water and dry with a soft cloth only.
2. If there is dirt, clean it with a mild liquid detergent or transparent glass cleaner.
3. Do not use any abrasive detergents, polishes, scouring pads, paper tissues, or scrapers.
4. Do not use acidic detergents, insoluble grain-based detergents, or soap.
5. Unscrew the aerator and clean it when necessary.
