

Hello,

Following our telephone conversation held today with your representative of the municipality, we would like to officially inform you that repair work on the two bridges P-10275 and P-09197 located on Route 301 over the Ottawa River in your municipality will begin on September 28, 2026.

We invite you to take note of the additional information presented below:

- Work from 28 September 2026 until the end of November with night work for the year 2026
- Work from the beginning of June 2027 to the end of November with night work for the year 2027
- Alternating traffic flow with temporary traffic signals throughout the day; a traffic lane with a minimum width of 3.5 m will be maintained to allow alternating traffic
- Complete night closure only during the week from 8 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
- Complete closure for 2 weekends with potential detour to Isle-aux-allumettes / Pembroke in 2026 and 2027
- A pedestrian link with a minimum width of 1 m will be maintained throughout the duration of the work
- The speed limit will be reduced to 30 km/ h for the duration of the work

We thank you for your cooperation and ask you to make the necessary arrangements accordingly.
