It is located in the temple of Wat Trimit, Bangkok, Thailand.</p> <p><b>Marble Buddha</b> - Wat Benchamaborphit Dusitvanaram is a Buddhist temple in the Dusit District of Bangkok, Thailand. Also known as the marble temple, it is one of Bangkok's best-known temples and a major tourist attraction.
