

ICELAND 6 NIGHTS/7 DAYS

Iceland, the 'Land of Fire and Ice,' offers a breathtaking landscape where volcanic craters, towering glaciers, and cascading waterfalls come together to create an awe-inspiring natural wonder.







ITINERARY

Day 1: Begin your adventure with a pick-up in Reykjavík, followed by a scenic drive to bingvellir National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site known for its historical significance and stunning rift valley. From there, head to the Geysir geothermal area, where you'll witness the famous Strokkur geyser erupting. Continue to the aweinspiring Gullfoss waterfall, where you'll take in the beauty of this iconic cascade. Afterward, visit the picturesque Seljalandsfoss and Skógafoss waterfalls, both renowned for their height and unique vantage points. Conclude the day at Reynisfjara black sand beach before arriving at your hotel on the South Coast.

Highlights: Reykjavík, Þingvellir NP, Geysir, Gullfoss, Seljalandsfoss, Skógafoss, Reynisfjara Beach.

Day 2: Start the day in the charming coastal village of Vík, famous for its black sand beaches and sea stacks like Reynisdrangar. Then, embark on an adventure to the stunning Katla Ice Cave, located beneath the Mýrdalsjökull glacier. After lunch in Vík, continue to the breathtaking Fjaðrárgljúfur canyon, followed by a visit to Jökulsárlón glacial lagoon, where icebergs float in serene waters. Don't miss the nearby Diamond Beach, where chunks of ice wash up on the black sands. Stay overnight in the coastal town of Höfn.

Highlights: Vík Coastal Village, Katla Ice Cave, Fjaðrárgljúfur Canyon, Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon, Diamond Beach, Höfn.



Day 3: Begin your day with a trip to the charming fishing village of Djúpivogur, where you can take in the stunning mountain and coastal scenery. After a stop in Egilsstaðir, continue to Borgarfjörður Eystri, renowned for its puffin colonies and rugged landscapes. Unwind in the relaxing warm waters of Vök Baths on the shores of Lake Urriðavatn before settling in for the night in Egilsstaðir.

Highlight: Djúpivogur, Egilsstaðir, Borgarfjörður Eystri, Vök Baths.

Day 4: Discover the breathtaking Stuðlagil Canyon, characterized by its impressive basalt columns and glacial river. Next, visit Dettifoss, the most powerful waterfall in Europe, and then head to the Námaskarð geothermal area, famous for its bubbling mud pots and steam vents. Continue your journey by exploring the mysterious rock formations of Dimmuborgir and the distinctive volcanic craters at Skútustaðagígar. Conclude the day with a visit to the stunning Goðafoss, known as the "Waterfall of the Gods," before settling in for the night in Akureyri.

Highlights: Stuðlagil Canyon, Dettifoss Waterfall, Námaskarð Geothermal Area, Dimmuborgir Lava Fields, Skútustaðagígar Craters, Goðafoss Waterfall, Akureyri.

Day 5: Begin your day in Akureyri, recognized as the "Capital of the North," and set out on an exciting whale-watching tour. Following this adventure, explore Glaumbær, a historic turf farm and museum, then make your way to Borgarvirki, an ancient volcanic fortress. Afterward, visit the remarkable Hvítserkur rock formation before heading to Kolugljúfur Canyon, celebrated for its stunning waterfalls and picturesque landscapes. Spend the night in Laugarbakki.

Highlights: Glaumbær Turf Farm, Borgarvirki Viking Fortress, Hvítserkur Rock, Kolugljúfur Canyon, Laugarbakki.

Day 6: Start your day by visiting Grábrók volcanic crater for incredible panoramic views, then stop at Glanni waterfall in the Húsafell region. Next, continue to the stunning Hraunfossar waterfalls, where water gracefully flows through lava fields. Afterwards, visit Sturlite horse farm to learn about Icelandic horses. Wrap up your day at Deildartunguhver, the most powerful hot spring in Europe, before settling in for the night in Borgarnes.

Highlight: Grábrók Volcano, Glanni Waterfall, Hraunfossar Waterfalls, Sturlureykir Horse Farm, Deildartunguhver Hot Spring, Borgarnes

Day 7: On the final day, explore the western coast, starting with Kirkjufell mountain, one of Iceland's most photographed landmarks. Visit Vatnshellir Cave, a lava tube cave, and the black sand beach of Djúpalónssandur. Enjoy the stunning scenery before returning to Reykjavík, where your adventure concludes.

Highlights: Berserkjahraun Lava Field, Mt. Kirkjufell, Snæfellsjökull NP, Djúpalónssandur Beach, Lóndrangur Basalt Cliffs, Arnarstapi Village, Búðir Black Church, Ytri Tunga Seal Beach, Reykjavík.
