

Terms & Conditions of attending a Corylus Collective event

I grant permission for the named child/ren to participate in all planned activities at:

- 1. Conifers School Holiday Club, Easebourne GU29 9BG
- 2. Ranger School, Sky Park Farm, Petersfield GU31 5PT
- 3. other local location

I understand that the participation in activities can expose the named participant to risk and possible injury including bumps, bruises, cuts, sprains, concussion, broken bones, stings, bites and other possible trauma.

Corylus Collective has at least one certified First Aider with the group at all times. I grant permission for them to treat the named participant in the event of injury.

I will provide Corylus Collective with all relevant medical information/medications for the named participant. Corylus Collective will keep these in a dedicated area and return to the participant on departure.

Any medical needs for the named participant including allergies/intolerances/regular medications must be fully disclosed on the booking form.

Corylus Collective will supply all tools and materials for the activities. Participants should not bring their own tools on site as it can lead to injury of the participant or others, or the items being stolen. I will not hold Corylus Collective responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged personal items.

I understand that it is my responsibility to ensure that the named participant is appropriately dressed for the activities and weather conditions; all activities are outdoors in all seasons. Corylus Collective uses gazebos, teepees and tarpaulins for shelters. Whilst Corylus Collective has a certain amount of spare clothing to offer, I understand that the named participant may be refused admission if they are not properly dressed and I will not hold Corylus Collective responsible for this.

Corylus Collective staff are experienced in running child-friendly fun activities. The named participant is expected to listen to and follow guidance from staff to ensure their safety and the safety of others. This includes the participation in activities, respectful behaviour and language, respect for the health and safety of themselves and others. Corylus Collective may remove the named participant from an activity or the full event should they not adhere to the above. I understand that Corylus Collective reserves the right to deny access to a participant who is unable or unwilling to follow guidance.

At our events Corylus Collective take photos to share on our website/Facebook/Instagram pages. We will <u>sometimes</u> take photos where the children's faces are recognisable. We mostly like to take photos of the activities including hands, feet and bodies, as it's great to show others what we've been up to. No children's names are ever included. I have stated my photo permissions preferences on the booking form.
