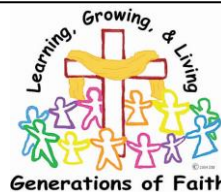

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

In the call by God to Isaiah in our first reading, we hear how Isaiah finding himself in the presence of God humbled himself. Isaiah writes, "Woe is me. I am doomed! For I am a man of unclean lips, living among a people of unclean lips, yet my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts!" In his humility, Isaiah's heart was opened to the Lord and he would be sent by God to proclaim the message of God's love and mercy as a prophet.

Peter in the presence of Jesus in our Gospel reading also responds to the Lord in a true spirit of humility. We hear, "When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at the knees of Jesus and said, Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man."

True humility recognizes our unworthiness of God's gifts in our lives. Both Isaiah and Peter recognized their sinfulness and through their humility, God was able to lift them up into His presence, forgiving their sins, and washing them clean. Humility is not an easy virtue to embrace. We live in a world of self-promotion. People seem to say in words and actions, "look at me." May God help us to live humble lives recognizing our need for God and one another.
