PASTOR'S MESSAGE

As the great celebration of God's limitless mercy and love for each of us, **Divine Mercy Sunday** is the perfect time to be completely reconciled with God. Some of us may be holding on to past sins that we mistakenly believe are unforgiveable. God's mercy is greater than the most serious sins.

Pope Francis recently reminded us of Jesus' words to Saint Faustina: "I am love and mercy itself; there is no human misery that could measure up to my mercy" (Diary, 14 September 1937).

Even one of his disciples, Thomas, had doubts about Jesus' ability to heal wounds. Thomas wanted to see Jesus' healed marks with his own eyes. But Jesus calls us to believe and trust that God will heal us even if we cannot clearly see and even when we find it difficult to accept His limitless mercy toward us. Pray for the gift of faith to believe in what is not seen.
