SAINT OF THE WEEK: St. Vincent Ferrer

St Vincent was a Spanish man who was known for his preaching. Everywhere people flocked to hear him. Many were converted the Faith. He was deeply concerned about the divisions in the Church at that time. He did much to heal those divisions that were caused by three different bishops claiming to be the Pope. Church council sought his advice. Because of his preaching and his healing of the Church, as well as his personal sanctity, he was canonized a saint in 1455 only 36 years after his death. May we all strive to live as one in Christ, and never cause divisions.
