CELEBRATION of the MASS at St. Patrick's

- The dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass remains in effect until further notice.
- Those over age 65 and those with underlying health conditions will be strongly encouraged not to attend.
- Face masks must be worn and social distancing of six feet must be adhered to by those attending Mass.

MINISTRIES DURING COVID-19 PHASE II – At this time we are greatly limiting the number of people who are required to be in our churches. As a result, we are not utilizing Altar Servers, having Deacon Bob serve as Eucharist Minister of Holy Communion (EMHC), not using Gift Bearers or conducting the Rosary at each Mass.

In meeting with a couple who are preparing for their upcoming wedding, the groom said, "Whenever people meet me or my future spouse, I want them to see that we are a reflection of God. People are often afraid to talk about God, to be known as a Christian, to witness. We want to take those opportunities ... those moments for others to see how good God is." In today's Gospel, Jesus says, "Whoever gives only a cup of cold water to one of these little ones, will surely not lose his reward." St. Therese of Lisieux' the "little way" was to do little things with great love. By pouring great love into the smallest acts. Frequently, I see so many acts of kindnesses of others in our community.
