- **May 14** -- No Mass. Adoration from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm



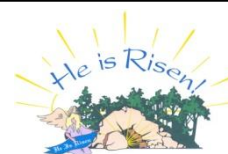

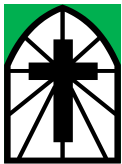


First Communion Day - St. Patrick's Parish – Sunday, May 12, 2019
