All around us, we see the effects of this Autumn Season: the colored leaves that are now falling to the ground and leaving trees bare. By the outward appearance, they appear dead. Though, we understand, that in the spring they will "burst" forth with life, again.

All Saints Day / All Souls Day are times when the Church emphasizes that hope which all Christians share for those who appear dead / dormant have been born into new / eternal life.

On All Souls Day, we pray for those who we have known personally. In Poland, people bring flowers and candles to cemeteries which become like gardens with mountains of flowers and ablaze with vigil lights that mirror our churches with the many candles at the Easter Vigil (Resurrection).

All Hallows Eve, All Saints Day, and All Souls Day, are times of hope that even as the grave claims our mortal bodies, there awaits a new and glorious body won for us by our Savior, Jesus Christ.
