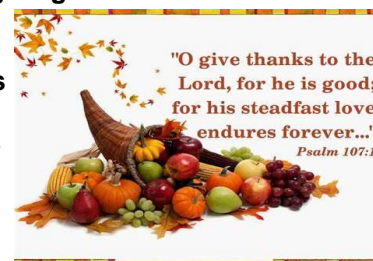

The present collection will contribute to supporting people from some of these parishes that have great needs and do not have the necessary funds. Priests from their diocese, who are serving us are: Fr. Luis Vargas (St. Francis Rochester), Fr. Miguel Proanos (St. Mary's Worthington), and Fr. Jose Morales (Mayo Clinic).
