BEE ATTRACTANT:
 Bees are attracted to blue, white, purple, and yellow flowers. Single-petal flowers are better than multiple petal flowers.

BUTTERFLY ATTRACTANT:
 Butterflies are attracted to red, yellow, orange, pink and purple blossoms that have short flower tubes.

(D) Deer Dislike: These plants are the least likely to be eaten by deer, but if a deer is hungry enough, they will eat any plant.

(H) Hummingbirds: Are attracted to bright orange, red, and hot pink blossoms.

(I) Inside also: Can be use as a houseplant next to a window.

To identify plants and bugs use the free phone app(android and apple) Google Lens does a good job.

* In container planting use Potting Soil.
 * In Ground planting mix in mulch to existing soil.

Taking Care of Your Flower Pots and Hanging Baskets

Plants perform better if Water, Fertilizer, & Chelated Iron are used regularly!

- **Watering:** 1 - 2 times per day, dependent on temperature & wind.
- **Fertilizing:** Once a week (Apply fertilizer to a wet pot, never dry)
 - In a 1½ -2 gallon watering can mix water with:
 - ¼ tsp of the *Ferriplus Iron* which keeps leaves green (1/2 of little end of scoop provided with Miracle-Gro)
 - 1.5 TBS of Miracle-Gro fertilizer (1 scoop of the large end of the scoop provided with Miracle-Gro)
 - Rotate every other week between *All-Purpose Miracle-Gro* and *Bloom Booster Miracle-Gro*
- Insect Control: take appropriate actions
- Deadhead spent blossoms by removing blossom with stem off at the nearest leaf. This will promote new blossoms.
- If stem of plant is getting long and "leggy", you may cut back the stem to 4-8" from the roots. This will tell the plant to bush out. You will see new blossoms in about 3 weeks.



^ Characteristic

"T" Thriller- Adds height and drama to the container. Typically planted in the middle or corner of the container.

"F" Filler - Fills the middle area of the container. These plants tend to have a mounded or rounded growth habit.

"S" Spiller - These gracefully spill over the sides of the container. They have blooms or leaves for contrast.
