Project Background

The City of Independence, Missouri has retained Kimley-Horn and Associates to develop plans for the improvements of **Winner Road between Route 24** and **Hedges Avenue**, located immediately west of the Englewood Arts District. This 1.5-mile corridor ranges connects the Englewood Arts District, Van Horn High School, and numerous residential neighborhoods, churches, and businesses.


In addition to improving the pavement, this project also contemplates enhanced storm water improvements, sidewalks, street lighting, and a multi-use path to connect the community.



Crashes by Severity per year




*Represents partial year only


