Member Spotlight! Rob "Ranger" Watson



Ranger knew at age eight he wanted to be an astronaut (and has the journal entry to prove it!).

His grandfather was a master machinist who worked on the Ranger and Surveyor lunar explorers that preceded Mercury, Gemini, and Apollo. His parents gave him science toys to support this budding interest, and he fondly remembers as a child putting on a motorcycle helmet and pretending to be an astronaut in the Mars-like red dirt of his backyard in the American Southwest.

In his junior year of high school, Ranger won a scholarship to study space science at Utah State University, which included working on a student GAS payload team. The experiment, which eventually flew on STS-95 in 1998, was an artificial heart valve serving as an analog to study cardiac fluid pressures in microgravity.

Ranger went on to a 28-year career as a web developer and is now the CEO of Webidextrous, a web and digital marketing agency in the Orlando metro area. But he never forgot his first love of space and regularly seeks opportunities to involve himself in space exploration.

Currently, Ranger is a World's Biggest Analog candidate and hopes to be selected and trained for the WBA event in October 2025. He is also the Executive Director of the Inspired 24 Innovation Team and the Web Manager at the Mars Initiative, a non-profit building an "X prize" to fund the first Mars mission.

The Innovation Program of The Inspired 24, which Ranger is leading, is the body or team of individual members of The Inspired 24 who are concentrated on space exploration innovations. Its full realization is pending sufficient organizational and operational funding for full-time, part-time, and contract employees. The vision of the program is to discover current and futuristic problems, and then research, analyze, and create innovative, cost-reducing, safe, and effective solutions for robotic/remote and human space exploration challenges. It is in the initiation phase of gathering applicants.
