That's a wrap for another inspiring class of spaceflight training at the Center for Human Space Exploration (CHaSE) at the University of Arizona!

CHaSE Class #4 participants included I24 members, Robert "Scout" Barnum, Jennifer "Jennway" Pint, Myah "Mogwai" D'Agostino, and Heather "Comms" Smith. Instructors included I24 members, Trent "Atlas" Tresch (lead instructor), and Andrew "Titan" Parris (assistant instructor).

On day one of this 2-day program, members attended classroom lessons on the history of spacesuit design and how to apply the science and math for pressurizing suits in real time. They also gained practical hands-on experience with donning (putting on) and doffing (taking off) spacesuits, as well as pressurizing the spacesuits safely and efficiently by working in teams.

On day two, members learned and practiced water egress training in the Univ. of Arizona swimming pool, including learning proper water ingress from a parachute harness and proper usage of water survival suits. They also worked as a team to navigate and enter a survival raft.

The program also included a personalized, behind-the-scenes tour of <u>Biosphere 2</u>.

Member Spotlight! Andrew "Lambda" Clifford





Like many of us, Andrew "Lambda" Clifford had a baseline interest in space and rockets as a child. He distinctly remembers seeing Space Shuttle footage in a classroom and thinking to himself, "That must be amazing to see in person, I should do that".

Fast forward to his college years. While he maintained a higher than average interest in space and rockets, it was nowhere near the obsession it is now. Lambda was just interested enough that when he and his family visited Disney, he had the thought to check to see if any launches were scheduled during their stay. And luckily enough, there was an Atlas V launch scheduled.

Lambda rented a car and made plans to see the early morning launch. After a long, tiring, hot day at Disney, his alarm goes off somewhere in the middle of the night. He was supposed to get up and start the hourlong drive to Port Canaveral for the launch.





But, Lambda had snoozed the alarm so many times, he believes he turned it completely off at some point. Luckily, he found the motivation to get up and start the drive. He arrived to a few dozen cars already in place to see the launch, and a brightly lit rocket on the otherwise pitch black horizon. After a few short delays, the Atlas V, carrying AEHF 3, took off, lighting up the completely dark sky like a sunrise. It was an emotional experience that forever changed the trajectory of Lambda's life.

Since that experience, Lambda is finding his place in the space industry. He is currently based in South Texas, documenting the development of the SpaceX Starship vehicle through his small YouTube channel / space media entity called *Rocket Future*.

Lambda expresses how happy he is to make this contribution to the community, and he continues to look forward to more opportunities. He still hopes to work directly in the space industry some day, and of course, he hopes to see our planet from above.
