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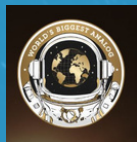
I24 & The World's Biggest Analog

From October 13-26, 2025, the World's Biggest Analog was carried out as the largest global "proof of concept" space simulation mission of its kind. Multiple analog space habitats conducted simultaneous research around the world, completing one shared mission: to answer the question, "How will we live and work in space as a community?"

Member Spotlight!

Elizabeth "Boo" Schneider



Elizabeth "Boo" Schneider's connection to space began in her early teens. Her grandfather was an avid amateur astronomer who hand-built a 10-inch telescope - personally ground its lens - and even constructed a small observatory to house it. Boo spent many summer nights with him peering through the eyepiece, looking into the vast darkness of the night sky, gazing at the rings of Saturn and the pock-marked moon. Those early experiences had a profound impact and ignited Boo's lifelong love of space and endless desire to share the miraculous wonders of the universe with others. Today, Boo channels that early awe into creating unforgettable space tourism experiences.

A former high school French teacher turned multilingual tour guide, Boo built her four-decade career around her love of people, travel and education. That experience and her passion about the cosmos, led her to found Galactic Medallion, a space-focused tour company offering personally curated experiences on Florida's Space Coast - especially at NASA's Kennedy Space Center. Each itinerary is designed around luxury + education + fun and often includes concierge-level hosting, expert guides, and access to storytellers who have worked inside America's space program.

BACKYARD OBSERVATORY - Lisa Schneider, a granddaughter of Mr. Goetz, stands beside her grandfather's backyard observatory from which the moon shot with its controversial "object" was taken. The structure, 8 feet in diameter and 6 feet in height, was constructed by Mr. Goetz using hardware and plywood. The hand-operated turn with the center sliding panel revolves at a 360 degree.



Through her recent acquisition of Canaveral Tours, Boo now offers guests a rare opportunity to explore the Cape Canaveral Lighthouse, a steadfast beacon that has guided ships to Florida's shores for more than 150 years and played a pivotal role in the birth of America's space program.

Thanks to an exclusive partnership with the Cape Canaveral Lighthouse Foundation, tours take visitors onto Cape Canaveral Space Force Station, where America's earliest rockets were launched - including our first Astronaut, Alan Shepard. Guests walk through original blockhouses, firing rooms, and preserved launch sites, gaining a firsthand look at where the nation's journey into space truly began.

As she looks to the future, Boo plans to continue growing her tour offerings and partnerships with aerospace organizations, educators, and the broader Space Coast community. Her focus remains on building meaningful connections between people and the story of space exploration while continuing to showcase the innovation and legacy that has made Florida's Space Coast unlike anywhere else.
