Member Spotlight! Brooke "Rose" Edwards





Rose tells everyone that the Moon was her first love. She has two lifelong passions: space and storytelling. However, she was led to believe that she could not have both, and put aside her dreams of space, resorting to space "fandom", like many of us.

She, too, spent most of her young life only dreaming of being part of something so amazing, so much bigger than us. Battling depression, Rose wandered into a job field she had no passion for, only because it was socially expected.

"Of course," she says, "normal people don't work in space!"

But Rose's curiosity and desire to be involved in the space industry continued to occupy her mind. After most of her family passed away, she found herself young and alone, continuously asking herself, "what now?"

Determined, she refused to let her career path keep her unhappy. Rose had to do something. She had to look back and find her calling. It was space and storytelling, and the idea of becoming a "space writer," whatever that looked like.

Over a five year journey, Rose was ready to give up hope. Her efforts of becoming a science communicator were not providing the income she needed. Job rejection, after job rejection flooded her emails. But then, one afternoon, it happened - she got the offer of a dream job: Space Reporter!

That was three months ago. Rose now looks back on what transpired after receiving that job acceptance email. She gave up all she knew. Her job, the benefits, a relationship, her comfortable routine... she was ready to accept her calling. Rose packed her car with her most important belongings and drove over 1,000 miles, arriving at the "Welcome to Florida" sign.

"Somedays, tears of happiness still flow with no warning," Rose says.

Today, Rose fulfills her purpose and calling as a Space Reporter for *Florida Today*, a major daily newspaper serving Brevard County, FL. She lives happily on the space coast chasing astronauts and rockets, along with her "space cat", Creamsicle.



But Rose won't be stopped at just "Space Reporter." Her goals are inspiring and achievable (especially as a member of I24). Not only does she plan to be one of the first 100 females to reach orbit, but to also be a space science communicator and Citizen Scientist.

As part of her path for accomplishing her goals, Rose completed I24's very first CHaSE spaceflight training in 2023, as well as certification in open water diving and G-force training up to 6G's. She continues to advocate for STEAM education and access to space for all.

In her own words, "nothing is impossible!"

The next I24 spaceflight training is quickly approaching! **Spots are still available!**

Here are the details:

- Location: Tucson, AZ
- Dates: Nov. 16-17, 2024
- Cost: \$400/day, so \$800 for both days (does not include air, lodging or meals)
- <u>Day 1</u>: pressure suit training; classroom & hands-on learning; working in teams "donning" & "doffing" pressurized suits
- <u>Day 2</u>: Water egress training in the Univ. of Arizona swimming pool; learn proper water ingress from parachute harness; proper usage of water survival suits; work as a team to navigate and enter a survival raft

This class will be led by I24's Vice President, Olivier "Chef" Barbeyrac!
