2. Submission of Full Proposals

- If your short proposal is successful, you will receive coaching support to prepare a full proposal.
- The optional coaching support aims to improve the value proposition, business plan, and investor pitch.
- Key deadline for the submission of full proposals in 2024: 3 October 2024

3. Interview with an EIC Jury

Successful applicants from the remote evaluation stage will be invited to an interview with an EIC jury. Interviews will be organized approximately three to four weeks after the remote evaluation results.

4. Negotiation and Due Diligence

If selected for potential funding, you will be invited to negotiate a grant agreement and start the due diligence process for the investment component.
