



## Warranty Company-Supplied & Aftermarket Parts Disclaimer

At Done Right Diesel, we recommend using OEM (Original Equipment Manufacturer) parts whenever possible because they are designed to meet the manufacturer's specifications for quality, fit, and reliability.

In some cases, an extended warranty company may require the use of a non-OEM, aftermarket, remanufactured, or warranty company-supplied part instead of the OEM component we recommend. These parts are selected and supplied by the warranty provider, not by Done Right Diesel, and we are not given the opportunity to evaluate or approve the quality or manufacturer of those parts before installation.

When a warranty company-supplied or non-OEM fuel pump (or other component) is installed:

- The replacement part is covered only by the warranty provided by its manufacturer or the warranty company.
- Done Right Diesel's labor warranty and parts warranty do **not** apply to failures of warranty company-supplied or non-OEM parts.
- If the aftermarket or warranty company-supplied part fails, any labor required for diagnosis, removal, replacement, reinstallation, programming, calibration, fluids, shop supplies, towing, downtime, or other related expenses are the responsibility of the customer or the warranty company unless those costs are specifically authorized and paid by the warranty provider.
- Done Right Diesel is not responsible for defects in, or premature failure of, customer-supplied, warranty company-supplied, or non-OEM aftermarket parts.

By authorizing repairs using a warranty company-supplied or non-OEM part, the customer acknowledges that they have been informed of these limitations and accepts that warranty coverage for the part and any related labor is governed solely by the part manufacturer and/or the warranty company.
