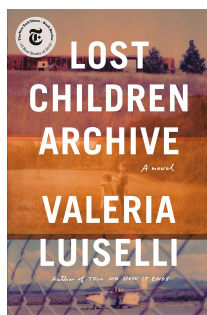
Blanche On The Lam by Barbara Neely* | This smart and sassy first novel in the Blanche White mystery series is written by a Lebanon County author.



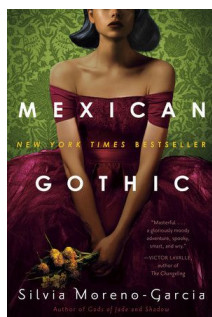
Conjure Women by Afia Atakora** | This haunting, multigenerational story about women with a talent for healing and conjuring curses is set in Civil War era Deep South.



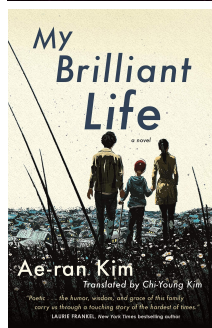

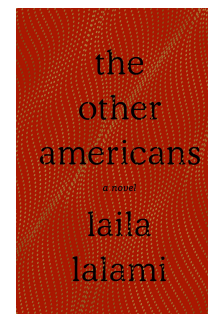

Mexican Gothic by Silvia Moreno-Garcia† | A genre blending story about a young woman investigating her cousin's claims that her husband is attempting to murder her.



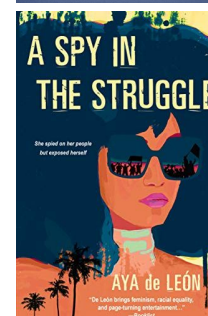

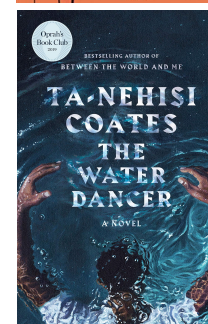
