I undertake : (1) To return the Warrant for cancellation :

- (a) if the Admiralty recall it at any time.
- (b) when I cease to be a member of the Club.
- (c) when the yacht ceases to belong solely to me.

(2) Not to use the yacht for any commercial purpose whatsoever.

I understand that the Warrant will authorize me to use the Ensign only on board the yacht named  
therein and on board any boat belonging to her which can conveniently be hoisted on board, and  
that the Ensign may be flown only while the Warrant is carried on board the yacht.

Further more the Ensign may only be used when the Burgee of The Royal Western Yacht Club is
