

EXHIBITOR GUIDELINES

College fairs serve the GPACAC region as important recruitment events for colleges and universities to promote their institutions to interested students, parents, and school counselors. The following criteria outlines who may register to participate in GPACAC college fair events.

- GPACAC invites any Title IV eligible and accredited college, university, or other non-profit postsecondary institution offering undergraduate curricular study leading to a diploma, degree, or certificate to participate in their college fair events.
- GPACAC membership is not required to register, but membership discounts will be available for some of our college fair events. A registration fee is required for participation.
- Specific academic colleges or extracurricular programs housed at two- or four-year
 universities are able to register to attend. Each individual academic college or
 program must purchase their own table space, unless they are a second
 representative attending alongside their parent institution. (Institutions may have up
 to two representatives occupying each allocated table space). On a space-available
 basis, registration will become available for academic colleges or extracurricular
 programs at a specified date.
- Non-profit organizations not affiliated with a college or university who assist students with the transition from high school to college may participate in the Oklahoma College Fair Circuit. On a space-available basis, GPACAC may accommodate college fair registrations for some non-profit organizational members. Non-profit organizations that would like to participate in a specific GPACAC college fair event should reach out to the College Fair Chair at collegefairs@gpacac.net before registering to see if accommodations can be made.
- All participants must follow GPACAC's College Fair Policy.
