To me – this represented the fruits of their love not only for their own children but as well as the thousands of children all over the world that they have helped. Likisina is a great example of the success of this work – her life in an extremely poor rural village doesn't bring much hope but today she is attending school in a country where only 10% of girls have a high school education. She is healthy and happy and best of all – she knows she is loved!

This first year as an official charity has been fruitful and productive and it is because of the inspiration, guidance and direction of Joan and Andrew.



Our SCM spiritual director said it well at the time of their anniversary: "I believe the unselfishness that characterizes your work can be traced back to the 'agapic' and Christ centered love you have for one another; a holy and faithful love which has not only endured but increased over all these years. I believe this is the center and core of CFFC and the seed out of which it grew." Just like St. Therese we are all called to be love in the Church in our own little ways.
