Mandatory Isolation Support for Temporary Foreign Worker Program (MISTFWP) Following the release of the federal budget on April 19, 2021 we would like to provide you with some information regarding the Mandatory Isolation Support for Temporary Foreign Worker Program (MISTFWP).

To ensure farmers have access to labour, Budget 2021 allocated \$57.6 million to extend the MISTFWP to August 31, 2021.

Under this initiative, support of up to \$1,500 per worker would be provided to employers until June 15, 2021 for some of the costs associated with the mandatory 14-day isolation period. After June 15, 2021, employers would receive \$750 per worker until the wind-down of the program on August 31, 2021.

Additional support – up to \$2,000 per worker – would also be available to employers to help offset a portion of costs associated with workers who are required to quarantine at a government-approved facility because they cannot travel by private means directly to their place of quarantine.

2. Federal Quarantine, Isolation and Other Obligations – Extended to May 21st

The COVID-19 federal Emergency Orders in Council (OIC) pursuant to section 58 of the *Quarantine Act* have been extended to May 21, 2021.
