1. Federal Quarantine, Isolation and Other Obligations – Extended

Canada's COVID-19 border and quarantine emergency orders were renewed August 8, 2021 to extend existing measures until September 21, 2021.

2. COVID-19 Sector Stakeholder Engagement During the Election Period

As you are all aware, Her Excellency the Right Honourable Mary Simon, Governor General of Canada, has issued the proclamation to dissolve Parliament and authorized the issuance of the writs for the federal general election, which will be held on September 20th. This means we are now in a writ period which impacts Agriculture & Agri-Food Canada's (AAFC) capacity to engage with stakeholders. While the Government retains full legal authority to govern under a writ, and necessary government work will continue, we are now in a period where government activity is subject to restraint under what is often referred to as the "caretaker convention." The caretaker convention reflects the need for the Government to confine itself to necessary public business and to avoid binding future governments to the extent possible.

We would like to inform you that AAFC's COVID-19 Sector Stakeholder Calls will be paused until further notice and COVID-19 Information updates **will be sent only on an 'as needed' basis**. However, AAFC will continue to monitor the RT account for any COVID-related issues or information that stakeholders wish to bring to the department's attention.
