2. <u>Minister Bibeau and Parliamentary Secretary Ellis launch federal consultations on the Next</u> <u>Agricultural Policy Framework</u>

On June 3, 2021, the Minister of Agriculture and Agri-Food, the Honourable Marie-Claude Bibeau, and the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Agriculture and Agri-Food, Neil Ellis, <u>launched</u> <u>the federal consultation process</u> for the Next Agricultural Policy Framework. The Framework is a wide-ranging federal-provincial-territorial agreement that will replace the current five-year, \$3 billion Canadian Agricultural Partnership, which expires on March 31, 2023.

Consultations begin in June 2021 and will continue through the spring of 2022. For updates on the consultations, summaries of the feedback received, and opportunities to contribute to the discussion, please visit the <u>Next Agricultural Policy Framework</u> throughout 2021 and 2022.
