# Test Decks – Current Laws

- The front line in catching programming issues and establishing confidence.
  - 12-17B-5. Testing system before election--Public notice.  
Not more than ten days prior to an election, the person in charge of the election shall conduct a test of the automatic tabulating equipment to ascertain that the equipment will correctly count the votes cast for all offices and on all measures. Public notice of the test shall be given at least forty-eight hours prior to the test by publication once in the official newspaper of the election jurisdiction. The test shall be open to the public. If any error is detected, the cause of the error shall be determined and corrected and an errorless count shall be made before the automatic tabulating equipment is approved.
  - 12-17B-12. Test of system repeated prior to counting ballots.  
The test required by § 12-17B-5 shall be repeated immediately before the start of the official count of the ballots.

# SD SOS Administrative Rule - Current

- 5:02:09:01.02. Test of tabulating equipment. The person in charge of the election shall conduct tests of the automatic tabulating equipment as required in SDCL 12-17B-5 and 12-17B-12. The tests shall be conducted by processing a preaudited group of ballots in a test deck marked to record a predetermined number of valid votes for each candidate and each measure. A tally sheet shall be created prior to the machine count to fully show how the sample of ballots is marked and what the machine vote totals must be to prove an errorless count. If more than one ballot is used in the election, a test deck shall be made for each ballot that is unique in any way. The test deck(s) shall include for each office and ballot question:
  - (1) One or more ballots with a vote for each candidate and each side of a ballot question;
  - (2) One or more ballots which have votes in excess of the number allowed by law for each office and question; and
  - (3) One or more ballots which contain an undervote.
- At least twenty-five test ballots shall be included in the total of all test decks. Individual test decks for individual ballots shall be of sufficient size to prove the accuracy of the system. If absentee ballots are to be received folded, at least ten percent of the test ballots in any individual test deck shall be similarly folded. The person conducting the test of the tabulating equipment shall date and sign the printout, verifying that the results of the machine's printed paper vote totals exactly match the tally sheet from which the sample of ballots was marked. The test deck(s), tally sheet, and signed printout must be secured and retained with the official ballots.
- The test procedure shall include the processing of at least one ballot completely blank to verify that the machine is correctly configured according to SDCL 12-17B-13.1.
- If more than one tabulating machine is to be used in the election, each machine shall be fully tested according to the ballot(s) which each machine will be used to count in the election.
- In addition to these tests, any test deck may be processed any time before or after completion of the official count.

- 5:02:09:01.02. Test of tabulating equipment. The person in charge of the election shall conduct tests of the automatic tabulating equipment as required in SDCL 12-17B-5 and 12-17B-12. The tests shall be conducted by processing a preaudited group of ballots in a test deck marked to record a predetermined number of valid votes for each candidate and each measure. A tally sheet shall be created prior to the machine count to fully show how the sample of ballots is marked and what the machine vote totals must be to prove an errorless count. If more than one ballot is used in the election, a test deck shall be made for each ballot that is unique in any way. The test deck(s) shall include for each office and ballot question:
  - (1) One or more ballots with a vote for each candidate and each side of a ballot question;
  - (2) One or more ballots which have votes in excess of the number allowed by law for each office and question; and
  - (3) One or more ballots which contain an undervote.
- At least twenty-five test ballots shall be included in the total of all test decks. Individual test decks for individual ballots shall be of sufficient size to prove the accuracy of the system. If absentee ballots are to be received folded, at least ten percent of the test ballots in any individual test deck shall be similarly folded. The person conducting the test of the tabulating equipment shall date and sign the printout, verifying that the results of the machine's printed paper vote totals exactly match the tally sheet from which the sample of ballots was marked. The test deck(s), tally sheet, and signed printout must be secured and retained with the official ballots.
- **The test procedure shall include the processing of at least one ballot completely blank to verify that the machine is correctly configured according to SDCL 12-17B-13.1.**
- If more than one tabulating machine is to be used in the election, each machine shall be fully tested according to the ballot(s) which each machine will be used to count in the election.
- In addition to these tests, any test deck may be processed any time before or after completion of the official count.

# Recommendations

- Require a prime number for each race with a unique number assignment for all ballot positions.
- Easier to catch programing mistakes.
- Ensures each candidate and ballot question is assigned a unique number of votes avoiding mistakes up front before an election takes place.

- Give the county auditors a prime number test deck that they can use to ascertain the accuracy of the programming.
- Update SD SOS Rules 5:02:09:01.02 to utilize a prime number in each race and unique numbers across the ballot

**5:02:09:01.02. Test of tabulating equipment.** The person in charge of the election shall conduct tests of the automatic tabulating equipment as required in SDCL [12-17B-5](#) and [12-17B-12](#). The tests shall be conducted by processing a preaudited group of ballots in a test deck marked to record a predetermined number of valid votes for each candidate and each measure. A tally sheet shall be created prior to the machine count to fully show how the sample of ballots is marked and what the machine vote totals must be to prove an errorless count. If more than one ballot is used in the election, a test deck shall be made for each ballot that is unique in any way. The test deck(s) shall include for each office and ballot question:

- (1) One or more ballots with a vote for each candidate and each side of a ballot question;
- (2) One or more ballots which have votes in excess of the number allowed by law for each office and question; and
- (3) One or more ballots which contain an undervote.

**(4) All candidates and ballot questions must have a unique number of votes used, and must not be repeated or used again anywhere on the ballot. Each race must utilize a unique prime number within the race that is unique and not repeated or used again anywhere on the ballot.**

At least twenty-five test ballots shall be included in the total of all test decks. Individual test decks for individual ballots shall be of sufficient size to prove the accuracy of the system. If absentee ballots are to be received folded, at least ten percent of the test ballots in any individual test deck shall be similarly folded. The person conducting the test of the tabulating equipment shall date and sign the printout, verifying that the results of the machine's printed paper vote totals exactly match the tally sheet from which the sample of ballots was marked. The test deck(s), tally sheet, and signed printout must be secured and retained with the official ballots.

The test procedure shall include the processing of at least one ballot completely blank to verify that the machine is correctly configured according to SDCL [12-17B-13.1](#).

If more than one tabulating machine is to be used in the election, each machine shall be fully tested according to the ballot(s) which each machine will be used to count in the election.

In addition to these tests, any test deck may be processed any time before or after completion of the official count.

# Recommendations

---

- Give the county auditors more time to fix programming issues by starting the process earlier.
- Establish deadlines to create certainty for auditors and vendors.

12-17B-5. Testing system before election--Public notice.

~~Not more than ten~~ At least thirty days prior to an election, the person in charge of the election shall conduct a test of the automatic tabulating equipment to ascertain that the equipment will correctly count the votes cast for all offices and on all measures. If it is determined that a reprogramming of the automatic tabulating equipment is needed, then a retest of the equipment shall be no later than 7 days before the election.

Public notice of the test or re-test shall be given at least ~~forty-eight hours~~ seven days prior to the test by publication once in the official newspaper, and posted on the County web site of the election jurisdiction. The test shall be open to the public. If any error is detected, the cause of the error shall be determined and corrected, and an errorless count shall be made before the automatic tabulating equipment is approved. In the event of an unresolved error, six days before an election the election jurisdiction must hand count all races on the ballots for that election.
