2. Have there been times in your life when you have expected Jesus to conform to your expectations rather than accepting Him as He is? How can you guard against this tendency in your spiritual walk? (Luke 4:22b-27)
3. In what ways can our church community be more open to embracing and welcoming those who may seem like outsiders, just as Jesus highlighted God's work among Gentiles and foreigners? (Luke 4:23-27)
4. How can we ensure that our familiarity with Jesus as a church community does not hinder our faith in Him but rather deepens our understanding and relationship with Him? (Luke 4:14-30)
5. What specific steps can we take individually and as a church community to allow Jesus to challenge our assumptions, expose our pride, and expand our understanding of God's grace to all people? (Luke 4:14-30)
