

Luke 3:1-20 Lifegroup Questions

1. Understanding question:

What significance does the political backdrop in Luke 3:1-2 have in highlighting God's sovereign control over human affairs and His redemptive plan through John the Baptist?

2. Personal reflection question:

How does the concept of repentance as a complete change of mind and direction, rather than just feeling sorry, challenge your understanding of true repentance in your own life?

3. Daily application question:

In what ways can you practically demonstrate repentance and turning to God in your daily life, following John's example of sharing with the needy and living with integrity?

4. Community/relationship question:

How can we, as a small group, support each other in living out our faith with integrity, especially when faced with societal pressures or temptations to compromise?

5. Specific action question:

What specific steps can you take this week to align your life more closely with God's will, following the example of John the Baptist in preparing the way for the Lord's coming in your heart and in your community?
